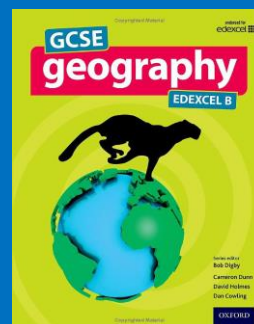

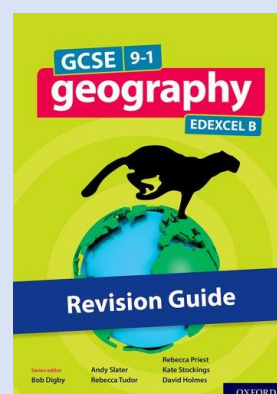
Geography opens doors into careers in Law, Journalism, Energy, Geology, Teaching, Construction, Conservation, Urban Planning, Climatology
