Attending every day at school and being on time to Form Time and lessons has a direct link to your progress. Last year, students with the following attendance percentages achieved these grades in their GCSEs:

EVERY DAY COUNTS

When you have periods of absence, this affects the amount of independent learning you will have to do in order to catch up with your peers. Having even one day off means missing five lessons, with potentially five different teachers across five different subjects:

0 days,
0 lessons missed 100% Perfect Attendance

2 days,
10 lessons missed 99% Excellent Attendance

5 days,
25 lessons missed 97% Good Attendance

10 days,
50 lessons missed 95% Below Average Attendance

14 days,
70 lessons missed 93% Poor Attendance

20 days,
100 lessons missed 90% Very Poor Attendance

PUNCTUALITY

Lateness also contributes to missed contact time with your Form Tutors and the carefully planned Form Time Programme. Being on time to school sets you up for a positive and purposeful start to the day. Wherever possible, you should avoid being late so that you do not miss important messages and activities. These numbers are calculated across a whole school year.

5 minutes late each day 3 days lost 15 hours lost

10 minutes late each day 6.5 days lost 32.5 hours lost

15 minutes late each day 10 days lost 50 hours lost

20 minutes late each day 13 days lost 65 hours lost

30 minutes late each day 19 days lost 95 hours lost
