Go4Schools

Go4Schools is an online system that allows you to view your child's progress, attendance and behaviour. As a parent, you have the ability to:



See your child's targets



Keep up-to-date with real time grade analysis



Look at your child's timetable



View your child's attendance from the start of the academic year



Be notified of behaviour events, both positive and negative

How to log on

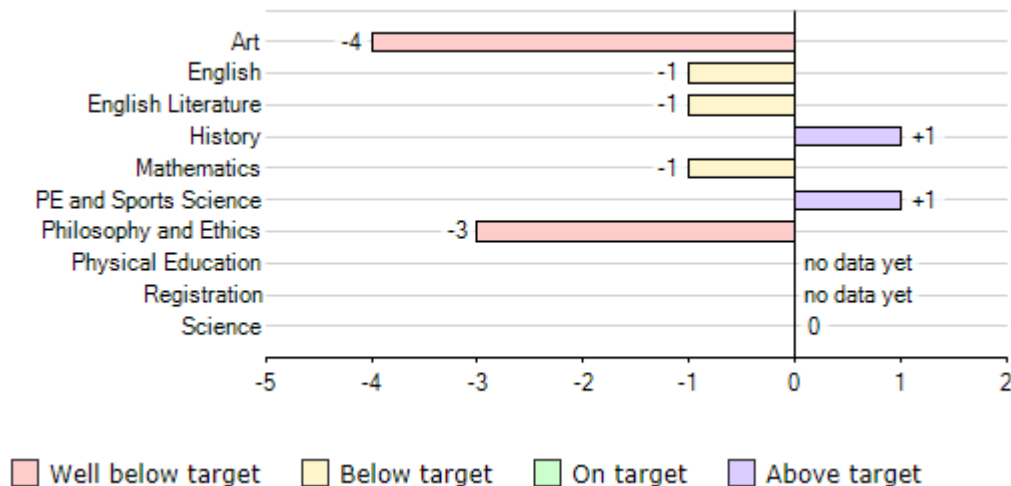
